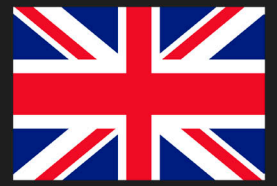

Stone-piling destroys the natural habitat of our flora and fauna

When we pile rocks one on top of the other it means vegetation ceases to be protected against strong winds and therefore the natural growth of plants is impeded



There are lots of insects, molluscs and reptiles that use the rocks to protect themselves and under which to lay eggs. If we move the rocks and stones, they lose their homes. By removing the stones we are also altering the area where birds feed and nest



Rock-piling is not one of our traditions and customs

It portrays a mistaken image of these islands and may also damage our geological, archaeological and ethnographic heritage



It can also put people at risk

Rock piles tend to be fragile structures and therefore the highest ones can topple over and injure someone. When there are so many of them they cease to serve as markers along paths and tracks and we can get lost
